When he was younger he never saw the point of having to learn beyond the scope of necessity meaning he could not comprehend why they were making him learn Latin when he needed to learn how to change the oil for a car in case his mom got sick again and his dad's MS flared up. He has spent multiple birthdays in the hospital because of me being hospitalized pushing me in a wheelchair while handing out cupcakes to nursing staff and fellow patients! That all being said, it is so refreshing to hear something positive rather than another correcting critique from somebody who doesn't have background content! He is really enjoyed learning and seems to have grown a lot in this particular class and I can't put in words how much we appreciate your guidance! He's a great kid who just needs to be caught up and given a chance! It is very encouraging to see his soul flame be ignited and to hear that he is able to help spark and ignite other fellow students soul flames for curiosity! I'm a huge advocate for bilateral stimulation and I do a lot with volunteering in the community with at risk youth and youth mental health first aid and wellness!
